The 1 day workshop on PCC Pavement Preservation includes reference documents, instructional material, handouts and computer based training modules that were developed in 2014 under a cooperative agreement between the National Concrete Pavement Technology Center (CP Tech Center) and FHWA.

All the documents were developed under the guidance of a Technical Oversight Committee that consisted of industry, State DOT and FHWA representatives. The materials presented in the workshop consider both optimizing performance and lowering the life-cycle cost of a concrete pavement.

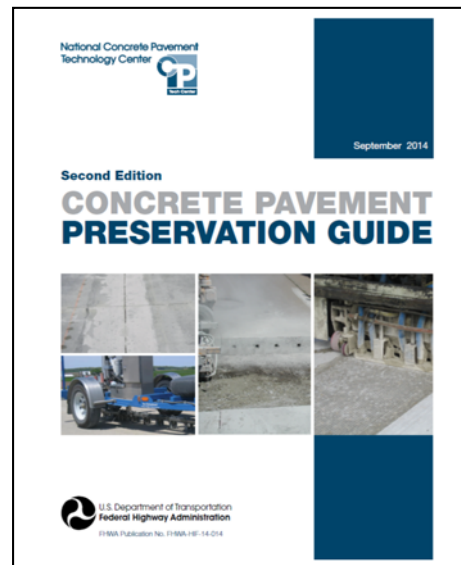
Who Should Attend?
