Applicants are required to submit all of the following documents in order to be considered for the \$1,000 scholastic award. Please forward the following documents along with the application form to the Wisconsin Concrete Pavement Association by **December 14, 2018**.

1. A current college/university transcript.
2. A listing of the courses being taken during the fall 2018 semester.
3. A written reference from a college/university professor.
4. The application form.

Recognition of Recipients

The selected recipients will be notified by mail at their home address between the Christmas and New Year's Day holidays. Each university will receive a check to their foundation for the amount of the scholarship with the instructions to apply it to your tuition.

Recipients will be asked and expected to attend the Wisconsin Concrete Pavement Association Annual Concrete Pavement Workshop to be recognized by the association members. The dinner will be held the evening of Thursday, February 14, 2019 at the Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel in Oshkosh, WI.
