  - University of Wisconsin-Platteville
  - Marquette University
  - Milwaukee School of Engineering
2. Student must be pursuing a Bachelor or Masters of Science in Civil Engineering degree.
3. Student must be an undergraduate with junior/senior status or graduate student status.
4. Student course work must have an emphasis in transportation, construction, or materials engineering.

### Recognition of Recipients

The selected recipients will be notified by mail at their **home** address. Each university will receive a check to their foundation for the scholarship with instructions to apply it to your tuition. WCPA will also invite each scholarship recipient to attend our Annual Concrete Pavement Conference to be recognized by the association members at a dinner on Thursday evening. Our 2023 conference will be February 8-10, 2023 at Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel and Convention Center in Oshkosh, WI. This is a great opportunity to meet potential future employers!

  - Do you have any work experience within the transportation industry?
